"Wow, that thing looks real," said Jack.


"Duh," said Wanda. "That's because it is real! The bad guys are going to use it to make their escape."


The Ringmaster and the Queen were standing next to the rocket. The crowd watched them from their seats.

Wanda sighed. "The Icylons are a deadly, snow-based life form," she said. "Not something you make for fun in your back garden."


Jack frowned. "I know that," he muttered.

"Well, that's good enough for me," said Wanda. "Even if I do hurt in places where I didn't even know I had places."




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A regular page turner

"It is," said Wanda. "Aliens have been visiting Earth for thousands of years. It's a popular place for family holidays."




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The Wolmump looked like a cross between a camel and a whale and was the size of a baby elephant.

Wanda rolled her eyes.


"How long do we have to look after this thing?" said Jack.

"Huh?" said Jack.


He got a small mirror out of his pocket. There was Wanda in the mirror.
