
My dad is a tiger trainer. My mum is an acrobat. We live in a trailer.

I write a circus blog. I film the animals with a webcam. They show my films in the big ring.






Deyda has one last link with his African home. It is his djembe drum. Deyda plays his drum all the time! It makes him happy.




But the man in the flat below hates Deyda's drumming. It is driving him crazy!

"I am working on my game," said Wei. "And it is not going very well. I cannot get this bit to work."






His Mum shook her head. "You are always playing on your game."


Wei stood up. "I am not PLAYING on my game, Mum. I am WORKING on it. It will be a very good game when I have finished working on it, but I need more time."

"Well done for reaching the basketball cup final," said their coach, Mr Reed.


Atash and Gulnar were both very excited about reaching the final.


"But the final will be hard," said Mr Reed. "You will be playing Mayland School."



"Hey look!" said Mariam.


Another small fishing boat was coming towards them.


The teachers were very friendly.

But the other children didn't like Tansy. A boy called Dave was rude to her.




