6. The roof of the world


Now you are looking up at the snowy peaks all around you. Those peaks above you are huge. That's why the Himalayas are sometimes called 'the roof of the world'.

Climbing gear

- ice axes
- crampons
 (Spikes to put on your boots to help them grip the ice)
 - ropes
 - a safety helmet
- oxygen bottles to breathe from
