“Good idea,” said Jack. “Let me finish my breakfast and I’ll meet you.”



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
“Where?”

“At the end of the road,” said Jack.


Ten minutes later, Jack was sitting on the wall at the end of the road. Next to a STOP sign.

“How many rooms are there in this castle?” Zak asked.


“About fifty, I think!” Jason said.

It sounded good, but Blaine was nervous.


The final of the Die-Hard Trophy was just a few days away and he badly wanted to win it.

Tom laughed.


Nick groaned and shook his head. Jed was a total pain. He was always on Nick’s case.

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Head over heels. Dino saw her head hit the hard steps on the way down.


"I didn't push her!" he said out loud.

“Brilliant!”



Su loved living at Moonbase 3. Her father was a scientist who studied the rocks on the Moon.

Next trip, she would be part of the team!




CHAPTER I NEWS INFO

“In a minute!” replied Tyler.


“In a minute!” replied Gail.

Sonia Rosa was a journalist. She had some news.


“A skeleton has been found in the rainforest.

“Not if I can help it!”


Harry quietly pulled on his wetsuit and tiptoed past Max, who was still asleep.
