
1. Awesome animals of the rainforest

Picture a top basketball match. The indoor stadium is packed with noisy fans. On the brightly lit court, two teams play for glory.



Lots of big parks and fairgrounds have rollercoasters.


These are giant rides that have trains or cars that you sit in to ride the tracks.

Bullet Coaster in Happy Valley Park, China






1. WHAT IS A STUNT?

There are two main types of stunt:


- stunts in films (pages 5-19)

Whether you're a playground star or Lionel Messi, a goal scorer needs to wear standard football kit – a shirt, shorts, football socks and shin pads.



I. THE GOALKEEPER'S KIT

Boots for grass and trainers for a hard surface are needed. Shin pads are very important as they can stop a goalkeeper getting badly hurt.

Tracksuit bottoms are useful because they protect your legs better than shorts. This is very true in a playground!

A goalkeeper's top with elbow pads can make your life as a goalkeeper a little bit safer. Goalkeeping gloves are important because they protect your hands and hold the ball well.

The speedway stars wear leather racing suits and coloured helmets. They look cool, like comic book heroes.


They line their bikes up at the starting gate and rev their engines to full power. It's time to focus hard on the race ahead.



Then the starting gate whips up into the air. The bikes rush forward and speed into the first corner. They are just centimetres apart, as they slide round the bend.


The racers have just one thing on their minds and that's winning.

1. The Fastest People On Earth


- Do you think you can run fast?
