3. CITIES

All Mayan cities were built in the same way.
They had a large central plaza surrounded by temples, pyramids, a palace and a ball court.
The plaza was used as a market and a gathering place for ceremonies and festivals.

Famous Mayan cities include Tikal, Palenque and Chichen Itza.

Pyramids

The Mayans built pyramids as tombs for members of the ruling family. The pyramids were also used for religious ceremonies. Some had steps leading to a temple at the top; others were not meant to be climbed.



The tallest pyramids were up to 60 metres high and could be used as landmarks in the rainforest.
