3. GIANTS OF THE WORLD

One World Trade Center in New York is the fourth tallest building in the world at 541 metres. It has 104 storeys.

It's the tallest building in the West and replaces the famous Twin Towers of the World Trade Center complex, which were blown up in the attacks of September 11th, 2001.



One World Trade Center was 'topped-out' in 2012.

'Topping-out' is when the last beam or girder at the top of the tower is put in place and the building counts as finished.

Often this is made into a big event and the media are invited.
